

## TIMELINE DATES FOR LEARN TIMELINE TASK

NOTE: These tell a partial story. Part of the exercise is for participants to add missing key dates (e.g. www, corporal punishment, women allowed to teach after marriage)

1850	'Every school-house should be a temple ... to the physical, intellectual, and moral culture of every child in the community.' Barnard
1850-1870	The ferule was used as both a pointer and a corporal punishment device.
1870	Magic lanterns use to project images in classrooms
1888	Ballpoint pen invented. 1888
c1890	The chalkboard started to be used—arguably one of the biggest inventions in terms of educational technologies.
1897	Education is not preparation for life; education is life itself
c1900	Mass-produced paper and pencils became more readily available replacing the school slate. c1900
1925	Thomas Edison said that "books will soon be obsolete in schools.
c1925	Film projectors became available in many schools. c1925
c 1925	NY city's Board of Education started sending lessons to schools through a radio station.
1930	<a href="#">Overhead projector in 1930</a>
1940	Ballpoint pens became a useful tool in the classroom (and life in general). 1940
c1950	Schools began to install listening stations that used headphones and audio tapes. C1950
1959	Photocopying introduced by Xerox. 1959
c1965	A secretary made this white liquid in her kitchen and sold it to Gillette for about \$50million.
c1970	The calculator introduced with teachers fearing they would undermine the learning of basic skills. C1970
1972	Handheld calculator
1976	First Apple desktop compute
1999	Sugatra Mita - hole in the wall research in a New Delhi slum

2006	Khan Academy is a non-profit educational organization created in 2006 by educator Salman Khan
2007	iPhone launched 2007
2010	The iPad went on sale in Australia at a cost of \$629. 2010
