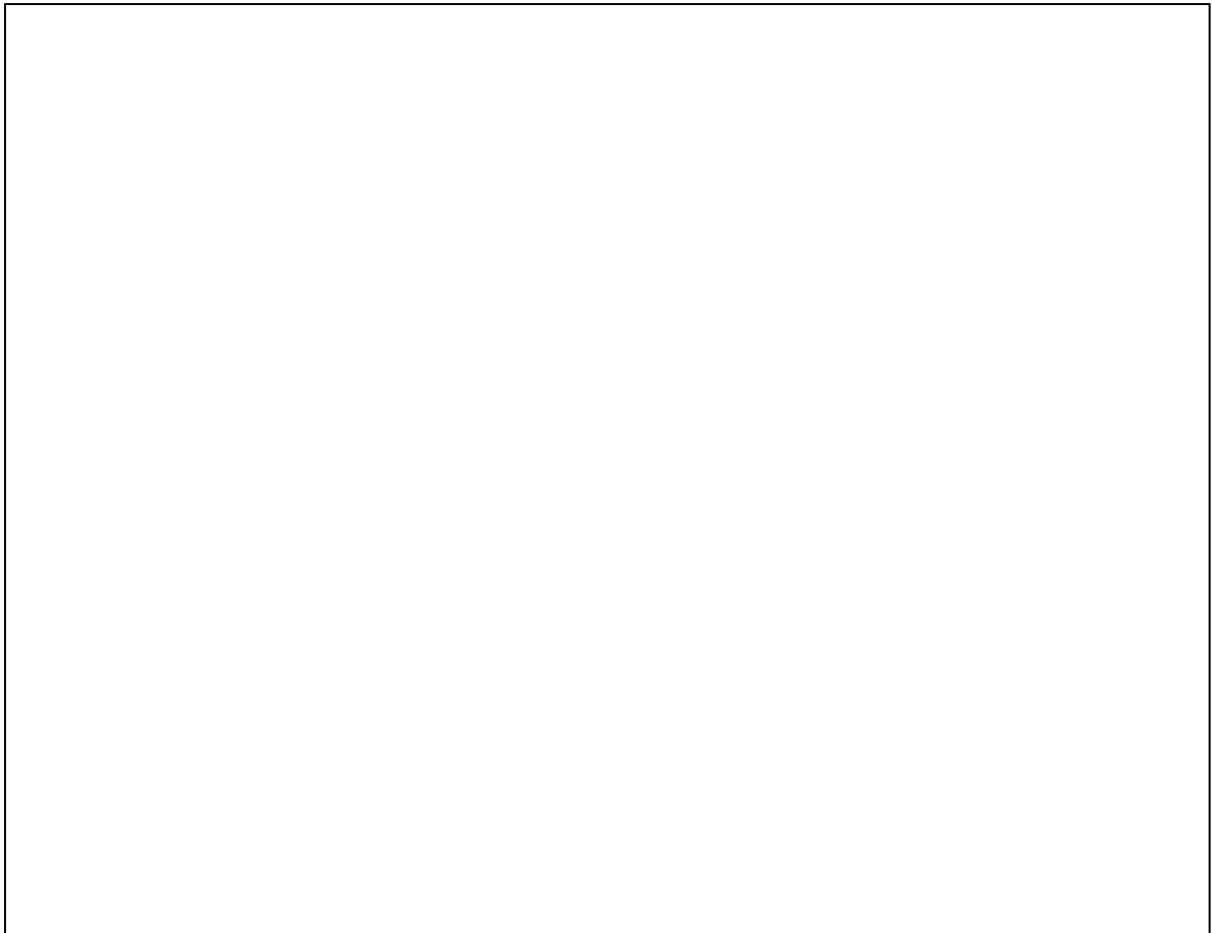
INDIVIDUAL PHD PROJECTS
